Brookdale Community College

The Transfer Advising Guide is a recommended plan of study. Additional courses are transferrable as outlined on NJ Transfer for this major with the approval of A Rider University Advisor.

Rider University

A – As of Fall 2014 the Department of Teacher Education has added a foreign language requirement of 3 credits to the Education curriculum.

U – Students have a number of options to satisfy this requirement; courses will be evaluated on an individual basis.

- Students are required to select a second major in a Liberal Arts Discipline.
- Middle School and Early Childhood Education Disciplines are classified as a Minor at Rider University.
- Brookdale students interested in the College of Continuing Studies (CCS) should contact that division directly.
- As of September 1, 2015 The **New Jersey - Department of Education** requires students to take and pass all sections of *Praxis - Core Academic Skills for Educators Test (Test Code: 5751)* prior to formal entry into a teacher preparation program.
- For transfer the Brookdale student must earn a grade of C or higher in all courses.
