For transfer credit County College of Morris students must have a grade of "C" or higher in all non-education courses. (No transfer credit will be accepted for any course with a grade of "C-" or below.) CCM students interested in the College of Continuing Studies should contact that division directly.

A – Student must earn a grade of "C+" in all Education courses for transfer.

Education students are required to earn a GPA of 3.00+ prior to student teaching.

Students are required to select a second major in a Liberal Arts & Sciences discipline or Multi-Disciplinary Studies with an Early Childhood Education Minor.
