Rider, College of Business Administration does not currently have a foreign language requirement.  $\beta$  - If CCM students take MAT-124-Statistics or MAT-130-Probability & Statistics, it transfers to Rider as MSD-200-Statistical Methods I. If MAT-126-Advanced Statistics is taken in the second semester, it transfers to Rider as MSD-201-Statistics II. Both cases waive the need to take MSD-105-Quantatative Methods for Business at Rider.
