β - If CCM students take MAT-124-Statistics or MAT-130-Probablity & Statistics, it transfers to Rider as MSD-200-Statistical Methods I. If MAT-126-Advanced Statistics is taken in the second semester, it transfers to Rider as MSD-201-Statistics II. Both then waive the need to take MSD-105-Quanatative Methods of Business at Rider.
