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Rider University Footnotes:

As of September 1, 2015 the New Jersey Department of Education requires students to take and pass all sections of the Praxis – The Core Academic Skills for Educators Test (Test Code 5751) prior to formal entry into a teacher preparations program.

^U – Students have a number of options to satisfy this requirement, courses will be evaluated on an individual basis.

CCM students interested in the College of Continuing Studies should contact that division directly.

A – Student must earn a grade of “C+” in all Education courses for transfer.

Education students are required to earn a GPA of 3.00+ prior to student teaching. Or below.)

For transfer credit County College of Morris students must have a grade of “C” or higher in all non-education courses. (No transfer credit will be accepted for any course with a grade of “C-“.)

Students are required to select a second major in a Liberal Arts & Sciences discipline.

There are two Concentrations available for the English Major: The Writing Concentration and the Literature Concentration. Writing Concentration: 13 Courses, 39 Credits. Literature Concentration: 13 Courses, 39 credits.
