As of Fall 2014 the Department of Teacher Education has added a foreign language requirement of 3 credits to the Education curriculum.

A - Must earn a C+ grade in all Education Courses for transfer

Students are required to select a second major in a Liberal Arts &Science discipline

Middlesex students interested in the College of Continuing Studies (CCS) at Rider should contact that division directly

Education students are required to earn a GPA of 3.00+ prior to student teaching.

Middle School, Early Childhood Education and Special Education disciplines are classified as a Minor at Rider University.

As of September 1, 2015 the **New Jersey – Department of Education** requires students to take and pass all sections of **Praxis- Core Academic Skills for Educator Test (Test Code: 5751)** prior to formal entry into a teacher preparation program.
