Education students are required to earn a GPA of 3.00+ prior to student teaching.

Middle School, Early Childhood Education and Special Education disciplines are classified as a Minor at Rider University.

As of September 1, 2015 the New Jersey – Department of Education requires students to take and pass all sections of Praxis- Core Academic Skills for Educator Test (Test Code: 5751) prior to formal entry into a teacher preparation program.
