NOTE: Electives should be selected in consultation with an academic advisor in order to assure maximum transfer of credits.

- 2 BUS-210, 218, 244 or MKT-101 are acceptable substitutes, provided BUS 230 is taken as one of the four general education electives. Select in consultation with an academic advisor in order to assure maximum number of transfer credits.
- 3 Consult academic advisor for credit transfer requirements.
- $\Phi$  HPE-111 is an acceptable alternative.

NOTE: Mathematics courses may not be selected as general education electives.

#### **Rider University Footnotes:**
